ESAO - Research AWARD 2005

The annual ESAO-Research Award is aimed at encouraging young scientists working in the area of experimental research, medical science, biochemistry, chemistry, physical chemistry, membrane science and chemical engineering involved in the general field of artificial organs, with special emphasis on:

1. New applications in artificial organs and regenerative medicine techniques
2. Membrane applications in artificial organs
3. New techniques in the field of blood purification.

The awardees will be selected by a Committee appointed by the ESAO Board of Governors.

The ESAO-Research Award 2005 of € 2500,00 will be presented at the XXXII ESAO Congress in Bologna, Italy to be held on 5-8 October 2005.

Each applicant should submit one original manuscript (with the applicant as the first author) together with 5 blinded copies to be used in the anonymous peer-review process. The manuscript has to fulfill one of the following conditions:

1. Published after July 1st, 2004 or
2. Accepted for publication at the time of application or
3. Simultaneously submitted for publication to the ESAO Journal (The International Journal of Artificial Organs).

A current curriculum vitae with a bibliography of the candidate's work should also be submitted. The applicant has to be under the age of 38 on June 9, 2005.
